REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION FOR REQUESTS

The following information is required:

1. Legal name of the organization
2. Address of the organization
3. Telephone number
4. Fax number
5. Email address
6. Website address (if applicable)
7. Contact name and title
8. Description of the program or project. Include a brochure or fact sheet if available
9. How will POPS be recognized for its support?

TO APPLY FOR SUPPORT

For consideration, organizations must submit a request for a charitable contribution to the POPS General Manager. If an organization is requesting support for a charity event or sponsorship, the request must be submitted at least 30 days prior to the event.
